2. PUBLIC HEARING & ACTION ITEMS:

a. Zoning Case Number 2021-02 #1: Zoning Board of Adjustments of the City of Nolensville, Texas will hold a Public Hearing to receive comments and take action on the following Zoning Ordinance Variance Request from R&R Industries, LLC (Robert L. Robison), 106 W Avenue G, Nolanville, Texas in the B-2, Neighborhood, Community Retail Business District;

SECTION 3.07.008 Prohibited signs; conflicting regulations

- (a) The following signs shall be prohibited in all districts within the city and in the extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ):
 - (1) Billboards. Installation of new billboards is prohibited.
 - (2) Electronic signs. Installation of new electronic signs is prohibited.

APPLICANT REQUESTS A VARIANCE FOR A DIGITAL BILLBOARD TO BE DISPLAYED ON THE SIDE OF HIS BUILDING.

b. Zoning Case Number 2021-02: #2 Zoning Board of Adjustments of the City of Nolensville, Texas will hold a Public Hearing to receive comments and take action on the following Zoning Ordinance Variance Request from by Terry Wayne Dickerson, 125 Boxer St., Nolanville, Texas in the R-1, Single Family District:

SECTION 551.2: Accessory Building

- (b) Setback requirements.
 - (B) Front. Accessory buildings shall not be located closer to the front property line than the primary building or the front yard setback requirement for that zoning district, whichever is greater.
 - (C) Side. Accessory buildings shall be set back a minimum of five (5) feet from the side property line. When accessory buildings are placed on corner lots adjacent to an exterior side yard setback, the accessory building shall be required to adhere to the exterior side yard setback established for the primary structure. Garages detached or attached to the main use building entering on the side street of a corner lot shall maintain a side yard of twenty-five (25) feet in the front of the garage.

APPLICANT REQUESTS A VARIANCE TO KEEP HIS CURRENT CARPORT ON HIS PROPERTY.
