Scope includes Mobilize, SWPPP, Erosion Control, Grubbing of Multipurpose & Baseball Field, Grading of Multipurpose & Baseball Field, Grading of 10' wide Walking Trail approximately 1500lft, Berm Seating, Hydroseeding of Multipurpose & Baseball Field, Supervision, quote excludes import and export of any material.

B. Discussion and possible approval to authorize City Manager to purchase of top soil for Multi Use Field Grading up to \$15,000.
