Have resided continuously in the corporate limits of the City for (12) months immediately preceding the date of election or appointment. 4. Not be in violation of any provision of the Charter. 5. Be 21 years of age or older on the first day of the term to be filled after the election or appointment; an 6. Satisfy any other eligibility requirements prescribed by law for the office for which they are a candidate.
