The following scope of work describes all the work to be bid as a single project.

The City of Nolanville reserves the right to refuse and reject any or all proposals and to waive any or all formalities or technicalities and to accept the proposal deemed most advantageous to the City, and hold the proposals for a period of 60 days without taking action.

Requirements:

- 1. Bid form includes fixed costs (which must include labor, equipment and materials as specified) and the number of calendar days set for construction
- 2. The project is primarily funded through funds from the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and Federal Land and Water Conservation grant funds. Attention is called to the fact that not less than the Federally determined prevailing Davis-Bacon and Related Acts wage rate contained in the contract documents must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must insure that employees are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, age or national origin.

- 3. The project must be completed within one hundred and twenty days after the issuance of the Notice to Proceed. A bid bond of five percent (5%) of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid. A certified check or bank draft made payable to the City of Nolanville or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond. Bidders are expected to inspect the site of the work and to inform themselves of all local conditions. A performance bond will be required from the selected bidder.
- 4. Evidence of ability to be bonded in to the amount set for the Bid Bond: \$150,000 and for Payment and Performance Bond in the amount of the Bid.
- 5. <u>Proposals must be submitted in an envelope sealed with tape and prominently marked on the lower left hand corner of the proposal envelope with corresponding proposal number and title</u>
