REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
THURSDAY, June 2, 2015

Mayor David Escobar called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and announced that a quorum was present. Mayor Pro-tem Butch Reis, Council members Aurelia Ridley, David Williams and James Bilberry were present.

1. INVOCATION:

Invocation was given by Chief Gary Kent.

2. PLEDGE TO THE FLAGS:

Mayor David Escobar led the Pledge to the Flags.

3. VISITORS/CITIZENS FORUM:

David Sutton – Says he did not receive a letter regarding annexation. He is opposed to being annexed.

Mario Martinez, Bobby Norton & Craig Brown – Withdrew their request to speak.

Jonathan Smith - wishes City Council to vote “no” to annexation

James Rader - wants full exemption from all City Ordinances and City Permit fees.

Michelle & John Jenkins – Mrs. Jenkins read a letter from her husband. She and her husband feels the City is wrong in doing this annexation.

Bob Pena – He explained that as a prior employee, this annexation was talked about in previous years. He appreciates the hard work of City Manager, City Council and City Staff. Mr. Pena explained that annexation is the right thing to do.

4. ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Kara Escajeda, City Manager provided more information on the Summer Feeding Program.

5. REPORTS:

- **Public Works, Animal Control, Ordinance Enforcement –Monthly Status Report to include Building Permits, Inspections, Ordinance Violations and Animal Control**

was provided by the Chris Atkinson, Director of Public Works. Mr. Atkinson also gave an update on the street maintenance being performed on the Plaza Roads.

- **Central Bell County Fire and Rescue** – Monthly Service Reports and Training and Educational Activities was provided to City Council. CBCFR staff were on call for emergency assistance to Fort Hood and not able to attend.

7. CONSENT AGENDA:

- A. Consider approval of Minutes for Regular Council Meeting of May 19, 2016 and Workshop Meeting of May 19, 2016.

Motion was made by Councilmember James Bilberry to approve the Minutes of Regular Council Meeting of May 19, 2016.; motion was second by Councilmember Aurelia Ridley. All voted in favor. Motion was carried 4-0.

8. NEW BUSINESS AND ACTION ITEMS:

- A. Discussion and possible consideration to approve Approximately 668.52 acres area of land for annexation into the City of Nolanville, Bell County, Texas under **Annexation Ordinance A 16-06:**

ORDINANCE NO. A 16-06

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF NOLANVILLE, BELL COUNTY, TEXAS EXTENDING THE CITY LIMITS SO AS TO INCLUDE SAID HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PROPERTY WITHIN SAID CITY LIMITS, GRANTING TO ALL THE INHABITANTS OF SAID PROPERTY ALL THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF OTHER CITIZENS, BINDING SAID INHABITANTS TO ALL OF THE ACTS, ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, AND REGULATIONS OF SAID CITY NOW IN EFFECT AND TO BE HEREINAFTER ADOPTED, AND ADOPTING A SERVICE PLAN; FINDING THAT ALL NECESSARY AND REQUIRED LEGAL CONDITIONS HAVE BEEN SATISFIED; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

Motion was made by Councilmember Butch Reis to approve Ordinance No. A 16-06 with the exception of Object ID 283, Property ID 232252 that will be moved to Exhibit C Development Agreements; motion was second by Councilmember David Williams. All voted in favor. Motion was carried 4-0.


B. Discussion Budget FY 16-17 meetings and timelines.

Kara Escajeda, provided a handout to the City Council displaying the future meeting and timelines for discussion of the FY 16-17 Budget and Tax Rate.

9. ADJOURNMENT

Motion was made by Councilmember James Bilberry to adjourn the meeting at 6:31 p.m.; motion was second by Councilmember Aurelia Ridley. All voted in favor. Motion was carried 4-0.

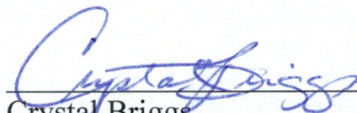
