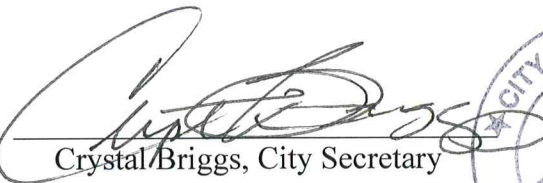
9. ADJOURNMENT
