A. Discussion and possible consideration to approve Ordinance No. F 18-09 #1:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NOLANVILLE, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2018 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2019; PROVIDING THAT ALL PREVIOUS BUDGET ALLOCATIONS SHALL BE SAVED; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

B. Discussion and possible consideration to approve Ordinance No. F 18-09 #2:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NOLANVILLE, TEXAS, SETTING A PROPERTY (AD VALOREM) TAX RATE AND APPROVING THE 2018 AD VALOREM TAX RATE AND LEVY OF (\$0.5265) PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) OF ASSESSED VALUATION OF ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

# THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 5.595668 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$28.80.
