3. NEW BUSINESS AND ACTION ITEM:

A. Discussion and Possible Action to approve **PROMISSORY NOTE** between TX Nolanville Apartments Ltd. Co., a Texas limited liability company and the City of Nolanville, Texas, in the principal sum of THIRTY TWO THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$32,000.00) with accrued interest thereon, at the rate of three percent (3%) compounding per annum. Accrued interest shall be payable on the first day of April of each calendar year (each, a "**Payment Date**") beginning on April 1, 2015, and continuing for five years thereafter. All outstanding amounts of principal, accrued but unpaid interest and other charges under this Note shall be due and payable on April 1, 2020 (the "**Maturity Date**").

Stephen Pearl, City Manager explained to the City Council the Resolution 2013-02-07 approved on February 11, 2013 supported this promissory note. He continued by stating this loan commitment would assist in acquiring funding and provide for support of the project. Mr. Pearl expressed the project has many overall benefits for the City of Nolanville.
